thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.*

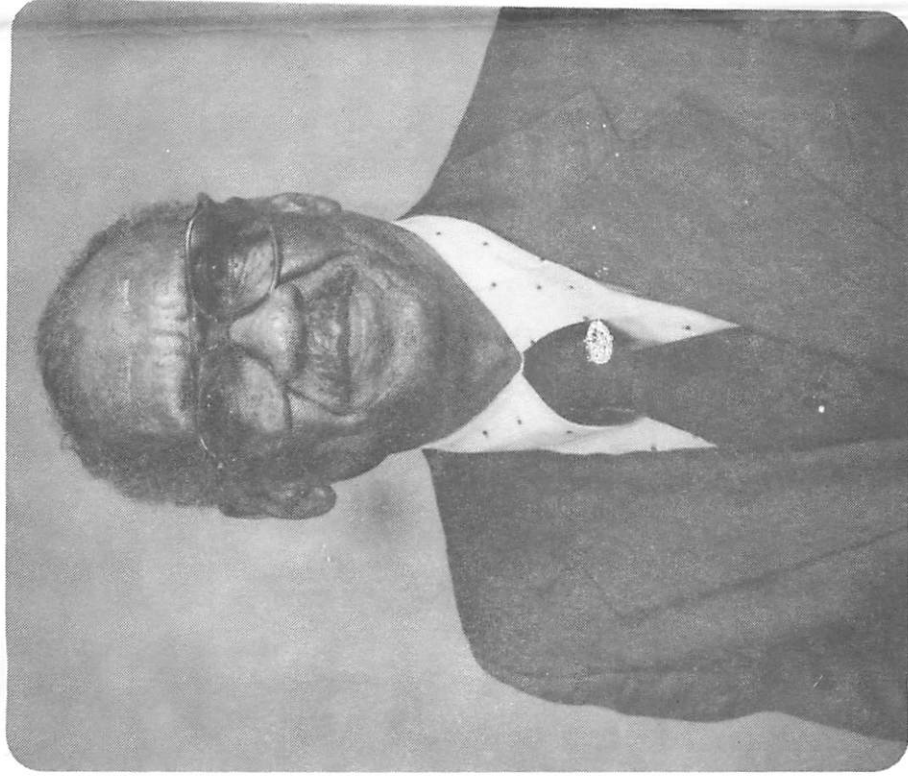
*Thou preparest a table before me
